
HAPPY SERENDIPITY DIY PROJECT

recently i've made up a sweet treat for the birds in our garden because i am still very hopeful it'll snow soon and it'll be freezing cold again. birds don't find anything to eat when there is snow so now they have a place to come to. it was really easy to set up:

cut a big apple in half and carve out a heart. a cookie cutter is very helpful! for the filling i've bought regular bird seeds in the supermarket and mixed it with 2 bricks of coconut oil. this works best in a warm pan - just make sure the seeds don't burn. when everything is mixed up well you can spoon the seeds into the apple. let this cool down and dry for some time. pin a screw into the apple and hang the apple somewhere in your garden. so sweet!
